BDLC Staff Fees and Refund Policy

1. Payment of the \$100 or \$200 deposit must accompany the application. No applicant will be considered until the application and deposit are submitted.
2. Payment of fee balances must be received prior to or no later than the second training date or seven weeks before departure, whichever comes first. If payment is not received by this date, the applicant will not be able to go on the trip and will forfeit the deposit.
